experience. The Pilot Project for teaching Italian as a Second Foreign Language in the Lebanese public schools and high schools, which was launched in 2001, after the signature of an Agreement for Cooperation and Cultural Exchanges, has been very successful.

Two years ago, the Fakhr el Dine Public High School took part in an international competition on

Pirandello, the great Nobel Prize laureate Italian playwright.

The third year's students of the secondary cycle, majoring in socio-economic and life sciences, wrote a screenplay named "The life permit"- under the guidance and support of Professor Mona Rizk - inspired by one of Pirandello's novels. The activity was supported by Professor Caterina Carlini, the Italian lecturer at the

Lebanese University.

The Fakhr El Dine High School ranked third among 84 schools participating worldwide! The Italian Ministry of Education, University and Research and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation invited the winning Lebanese students and their teacher to present their play during the award ceremony held in June 2018 in Agrigento.
